CRYPTOZOOLOGY

Dr. Shopba , an eccentric Kyrgyzstani scientist, had dedicated his life to finding and cataloging mysterious beasts – or *cryptids* – around the world.

Being a touch paranoid, he guarded his notes carefully, concealing the key terms in two obscure alphabets: **OLD BURGUNDIAN** and **ANCIENT** AZURIAN.

Dr. Shopba was consumed by his work – literally. Only his notes and his gnawed bones remained to tell of the legendary creatures he had discovered.

INSTRUCTIONS

First, uncover the locations of the cryptids by deciphering the remaining encrypted words in the notes.

Next, using the clues in the notes, determine where each cryptid is found on the map. Only one cryptid lives in each sector of the grid.

Finally, when you have identified all of the cryptids and their habitats, use that information to discover which cryptid put an end to Dr. Shopba's research.

Notes:

References to specific cities or countries are not hints to the creature's current location. A reference to "Los Angeles" does not mean the creature will be found on the west side of the map. However, a reference to "living in the west" *is* a clue to the creature's location.

"Neighboring" means any contiguous sector, including diagonals.

A map sector's terrain is the predominant terrain. A sector that contains primarily mountains with a few trees should be considered mountainous terrain, not forest.

CPRIWBALHAW

A likeness of this legendary creature adorns the top of many Native American OMOWS IMPWK, especially in the UZRICGHIQ of the IZACPYBQC, where its titanic wings are believed to stir the wind.

GWOA

Like its neighboring cousins the JWLHAUM and the QAUTMMO, the GWOA is a shaggy humanoid that some speculate may be the missing link in human evolution.

EGSXGKZOB

The EGSXGKZOB is believed to be the offspring of a pygmy deer and a killer EGSX AGLLHC. These creatures would overrun their habitat in the IZACP plains if not for the neighboring KZRO NGAZR on one side and PHIXTORIX on the other.

MUMIMUM

The MUMIMUM is a PEYW-dwelling beast, described as a 50' long QBAOBIC.

SPROGSGLAG

The SPROGSGLAG or "NZGC QRSXBA" gets its name from its habit of drinking the blood of UMEOK, DMJK, and other KHMBQCZSX. Although famous in the Caribbean (particularly Puerto Rico, the Dominican Republic, and EGUGHSG), it is a solitary creature that prefers the fewest neighbors possible, and has migrated far to the north to escape the relentless spread of humanity.

REUUAK

The JAPH REUUAK is a quadruped inhabiting the JWKOWXLSMKO highlands, and was once believed to be the source of the traditional Scottish dish REUUAK.

YBIWHNZ

Neighbor and close relative of the TBCH, the YBIWHNZ is a hairy GOB-UGI who inhabits frigid mountaintops. Where the TBCH eats sheep and yak, and the LHNJZZC eats twigs and berries, the YBIWHNZ hungers only for human flesh.

HXEUML

The reptilian HXEUML is the source of legends around the world, most notably in Europe and Asia. In these myths, the HXEUML is closely connected to and surrounds itself with JEOWX, living in PEYWK, AHMBAQ, or on remote AKPELHK. In Asia, it is considered an omen of NZZW KRSX – 2012 was the Year of the YGCBA WAGNZI. But in Europe, where WAGNZIQ have a taste for human blood, those who stumble across them are anything but PNDYG.

EBAQBT WBMHK

Described as a flying, two-legged creature with the head of a NZGC, leathery YHINQ, and hooves, the fearsome EBAQBT WBMHK now lends its name to a national PZSXBT CBGU. Although originally from LWJEXY, it fled from the influx of noisy LWJ GMXYWXK, and now prefers the central plains exclusively.

QAUTMMO

The star of several blurry TAPS SKHOQ, QAUTMMO is a huge, smelly, hairy beast found in dense TMXWKO regions. Despite their similarities, the JWLHAUM and the LHNJZZC will fight to the death, and so are never found in proximity to one another.

QXTJHQP

The QXTJHQP, sometimes known simply as AZWQ, were first recorded near the infamous GABG 51 in AZQYBKK. Because of this, many believe them to be flying GKHBIQ. QXTJHQP have been spotted skimming over flat, low-lying terrain.

SMORSEL

A humanoid creature with a 10' JALUKIEL and glowing red eyes, the SMORSEL terrorized the WEKO DMEKO in 1966. It remains there to this day.

PZZO QIGXB

This unusual **QIGXB** travels by grasping its **CGHK** in its **UZRCP** and rolling after its prey. It is **MRKIBAGLKB** to attacks from the air, and will not be found near flying creatures.

PMNI UEXMN

When the SMML is TNPP, the howls of the JMPTSEL echoes across the LMXORWXL plains.

YTMBAI

A wingless cousin to the WAGNZI, this venomous, bipedal ABOCHKB prefers arid regions.

RALYGINLY

The RALYGINLY, or JAPP-M'-ORW-JAKI, is a ghostly PAURO found in swamps and SEXKRWK. It is rumored to lure travelers to their death.

QGCTA

This legendary NZGC-UGI, the QGCTA, is fond of music and will sometimes leave his JZABQC to rock out to QOAHINQCBBI tapes with the EBAQBT WBMHK to the IZACPBGQC. The QGCTA surrounds itself with bipeds: they dance better.

SWXSEAH

SWXSEAHK are aquatic creatures which may have originated with sailors' sightings of KWE DMJK (much to their chagrin). The SWXSEAH has appeared in popular TEAXG tales, and in 1997, one became the fourth HAKLWG IXALDWKK (to their even greater chagrin). SWXSEAHK are found in warm southern climates.


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
