

Bookworms

First, place the 42 books in the slots on the board. Each book will fall into a category (designated by the 10 colored bookworms).

For example, one worm might cover “Books set in Georgia,” and could include *Driving Miss Daisy*. Another might represent “Titles about Weather,” and could include *Snow Crash*. Where those two worms cross, you might place *Gone with the Wind*, which fits both categories.

The Hint Sheet will help you narrow down which books go in which slots.

When you're sure of a book's position, write its title in the appropriate slot below. (Include spaces, and articles such as "the", and "a"; exclude punctuation.) The yellow and blue shaded squares will spell out the final quote.
